



## Vehicle Transport Checklist

### **Climate Transition**

Vehicles should be prepared for transition to a new climate. This may include engine coolant, transmission oil, and other fluids. Mike's Transport is not responsible for damage caused by lack of preparation.

### **Keys**

Mike's Transport requires that 1 set of keys be provided for your vehicle. It is the dealer's responsibility to ensure that all manuals, paperwork and extra keys be safely stowed in the glove box.

### **Personal Property**

No personal belongings may be shipped with the vehicle.

### **Alarms**

Alarms should be disarmed. Please inform Mike's Transport of any special instruction required to shut vehicle alarm off.

### **Damaged Glass**

If vehicle glass has a chip, scratch or any other condition, it may result in a full crack during transit, in this case Mike's Transport will not be responsible.

### **Non-permanent Racks**

Any non-permanent luggage, ski, bike, etc. racks should be removed.

### **Vehicle Ground Clearance**

All after market low hanging items should be removed, or sufficient clearance be assured, to ensure safe loading of vehicle onto trailer. Mike's Transport will not be responsible for damaged vehicles because of lack of clearance.
